We are pleased that you are considering Tillamook Bay Community College to further your education. Upon admission, all students attending TBCC will be assigned a unique and randomly generated identification number. This permanently assigned identification number is directly connected with students' academic records and used by our students to access their own confidential enrollment and registration records. TBCC uses this student identification number whenever possible.

TBCC will request Social Security Numbers (SSN) at the time of application. The SSN will not be used as the student ID number but will be provided to entities requiring SSNs, including, but not limited to, the federal government for financial aid and Tax Relief Act (1997) reporting, the US Department of Homeland Security, and the Oregon Community College Unified Reporting System (OCCURS). Your SSN may be used in connection with the developing, validating or administering predictive tests and assessments; improving instruction; internal identification of students, collection of student debts; automated verification functions, including enrollment. Students who choose not to provide their SSN will be ineligible for financial aid, and deferred payment and other financial arrangements. If you provide your SSN to TBCC, you consent to allow TBCC to use the number in the manner described.
